- A comprehensive set of story-based resources, including teacher handbook, lesson slides for each unit, videos, flyers and activity templates.

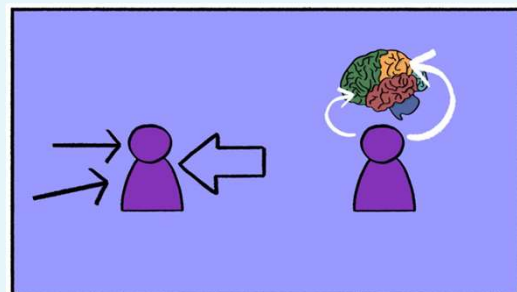
